<u>Trunk-n-Treat</u>: The Trunk-n-Treat event is Mt. Moriah's major outreach event to the Byron Community. Plans are in place to hold the event Thursday, October 31, 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

The LCMS has released what they call "The Lutheran Citizenship Guide." This is a document that used to be called the "Lutheran Voter Guide."

They mention that they are broadening the focus of their comments and guidance this year. No longer restricting their discussion to specific political issues or specific pieces of legislation, they will instead be offering thoughts regarding the attitudes and approaches that Lutheran Christians might consider as they seek to be faithful in serving their neighbor through the exercise of citizenship.
