Remember the many songs of the Christian faith you learned as a child? Even today, many of those songs remain deeply rooted in your memory, continuing to teach the Word years – even decades – after you first learned them.

In Africa too, music is a huge part of daily life, including in the life of the Church. But in Africa's new and even long-time Lutheran churches, a challenge exists: the number of songs to imprint the faith in children's hearts and minds is very limited. There are no children's hymnals or song books to teach from. Teachers are limited to the songs that they can remember themselves. LHF has started work on a new translation project called "Praise Him, Africa!"
